Projecting
Articulate
Breathe

Drop the jaw
Memorize songs
Slow down
Act with voice
Pitch
Timing
Confidence

Dance (can incorporate some of these into Games)

Box step
Grapevine
Spatial awareness
Pivot
Don't look at feet (or neighbor)
Left vs. Right
Resilience even if you forget (don't break face)
March
Step and clap simultaneously
Big arms (even when marching)
Confidence in face

Teamwork
Patience
Pay attention / Listen to instructions
Respect others
Personal integrity (teach what that means)
Cleanup song
You get what you get...

Juniors

Respect people and property
Bubbles in mouth
Praise and attention to each kid (does wonders for behavior)
